

Cell Organelle RAFT

What's a RAFT? Well... it stands for:

R = ROLE

A = AUDIENCE

F = FORMAT

T = TOPIC



And for this assignment specifically, it looks like this:

R = You are a cell organelle and are applying for a job in a newly made cell

A = Interview committee for the Cell

F = Persuasive Essay

T = Describes what organelle you are, why you would be valuable to the cell, and why it would be better to hire you over any other organelle.

Points to Hit in your RAFT:

- Describe you as an organelle- a description, your function, your location, what type of cell(s) you would be found in, etc
- Describe why you are valuable to the cell
- Describe at least 5 other organelles that would be found in your cell with their functions and why you are the better choice for hire
